The Course

The course is made up of four units — two taken in each year.

Year 12 AS

Unit 1 - Art & Design Coursework

Students are able to work in a wide range of media to produce a body of coursework on a theme

Unit 2 - Art & Design Externally set Assignment

Students work to a set title to produce preparatory studies together with a final piece in the 8 hour exam

Year 13 A2

Unit 4 - Art and Design Coursework

Students may choose a specialism and theme to work with in order to produce a body of coursework together with a 1000 word personal study on the work of other artists / designers

Unit 5 - Art and Design externally set Assignment

Students work to a set title to produce preparatory studies together with a final piece in the 12 hour exam
