The Course

-The course is made up of Four modules — Two taken in each year.

Year 12 AS

Module 1 (F761)—Managing Physical Environments. - Physical processes and features of the physical environment (e.g. Coasts, rivers, hot deserts).

Exam is 1 hour 30 minutes taken in January. (worth 50% of the AS: 25% of the A- level)

Module 2 (F762)- Managing Change in Human Environments (e.g Rural change, Energy and Tourism).

Exam is 1 hour 30 minutes taken in June. (worth 50% of the AS: 25% of the A-level).

There is no major investigation to be examined at AS, but investigation will take place as part of the course.

Year 13 A2

Module 3—(F763)—Global Issues (e.g. Earth, Hazards, Ecosystems and Globalisation). -

Exam is 2 1/2 hours taken in January. (worth 30% of the A- level)

Module 4—(F764)—Geographical skills. - Exam is 1 1/2 hours taken in June. (worth 20% of the A- level). Geographical enquiry with an exam that draws on knowledge of enquiries / fieldwork.
